

Credit card Property tax payments Instructions

Jill Mihelich, Ouray County Treasurer, is pleased to provide taxpayers with the convenience of using a major credit card as a form of payment for **current year PROPERTY TAXES**.

VISA and MASTER CARD are accepted. Payments will be accepted for complete half payment or full payment thru Certified Payments. To pay property taxes with a Credit Card, go to Ouray County Treasurer Website: <https://ouraycountytreasurer.org/treasurer/web/>

Click "I Have Read the above Statement" and on the next screen under PUBLIC USER LOGIN click "Login".

Type in account number, or search for the account number by owner name. The account summary shows the total taxes due. If paying the first half, select "first" and that amount will be indicated.

To proceed to payment page click on Certified Payment (2578809) in the purple bar and the Certified Payments website comes up.

Be sure you have the Property Tax account number, and correct amount of payment.

Type in the bureau code 2578809 then click on "Begin payment".

Enter payment amount and Property tax account number and select card type VISA or Master Card. Discover and American Express cards are not accepted.

Continue, listing credit card number, etc.

When asked to give an address, list the billing address for the credit card.
