

**Ouray County
Resolution**

Re: Notice of Intent to Place Questions on November, 2002 Ballot

Whereas, the Board of Ouray County Commissioners through the adoption of this resolution is officially notifying the Ouray County Clerk and Recorder of their intent to place two questions on the November 5, 2002, General Election Ballot; and

Whereas, the first question would authorize Ouray County to collect a 1% Use Tax on building materials within Ouray County, with such Use Tax to be expended exclusively for the conservation, acquisition, and protection of open space and related purposes; and

Whereas, the second question, would authorize Ouray County to collect, retain and expend all revenues and other funds collected from any source with no increase in the property tax mill levy or the sales tax rate, without further voter approval; and

Whereas, the Ballot Questions further asks that such collections, retention's and expenditures be exempt from any limitation contained in Article X, Section 20 of the Constitution of Colorado.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Ouray County Board of Commissioners, through adoption of Resolution Number 2002-028 hereby notifies the Ouray County Clerk and Recorder pursuant to 1-7-116 (5) of Ouray County's intent to participate in the November 5th, 2002 General Election with the placement of two ballot questions.
