REGARDING: CITIZEN CORPS COUNCIL

Whereas, The President of the United States, acting through the Federal Emergency Management Agency, has recommended the local creation of Citizen Corps as part of the USA Freedom Corps initiative, and

Whereas, the purpose of the Citizen Corps is to help coordinate volunteer activities that will make our communities safer, stronger, and better prepared to respond to emergency situations, and

Whereas, the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) currently performs many of the Citizen Corps Council roles, and

Whereas, The President encourages local leaders to use existing structures as they set up Citizen Corps Councils.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, hereby designates the Local Emergency Planning Committee as the Citizen Corps Council to perform those functions outlined by President George W. Bush on April 4, 2002.
