At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners for Ouray County, Colorado held at the Court House, Ouray, Colorado on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D., 2003.

When the following proceedings, among others, were had and done, to-wit:

**WHEREAS**, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 25-1-608, declares that the Board of County Commissioners of each county shall be a Board of Health for its respective county; and

**WHEREAS**, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 25-1-610, requires that:

Every local Board of Health shall appoint one or more physicians to the Board who shall be the Health Officers of the County . . . and hold office at the pleasure of the Board.

**AND, WHEREAS**, 9 Sanders, M.D., is a well-educated and suitable physician and complies with all statutory requirements to be appointment as County Health Officer in Ouray County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED**, that 9 Sanders, M.D., be appointed for the year 2003 to serve at the pleasure of the Board of County commissioners, County Health Officer for Ouray County, Colorado, and that 9 Sanders, M.D., be compensated for her services as County Health Officer at the rate of \$25.00 per day, or a portion thereof, in which services are rendered.
