

RESOLUTION
OF
THE BOARD OF OURAY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Re: **Citizen Adoption of County Road Segments for Alternative Weed Control**

Whereas, a citizens group known Citizens for Alternative Treatment of Pests and Weeds (CATPAW), has requested permission from the Board of County Commissioners to adopt segments of specific County Roads concerning alternative weed control methods; and

Whereas, the specific roads being requested for implementation of alternative weed control are listed below:

- County Road 17 from Suzanne Lane north to the intersection of County Roads 17 and 23, at the third cattle guard (south of the San Juan Guest Ranch),
- From the intersection of County Road 22 and Sage Road, west and south to the end of County Road 22,
- County Road 24 from Windfall Subdivision to Pleasant Valley Vista Subdivision, and
- County Road 1 from County Road 24 up the hill towards Log Hill, and ending at the second set of concrete barricades at the end of the guard rail; and

Whereas, it is necessary to place signage or markers indicating the designated road segments that are being treated with non-chemical weed control methods; and

Whereas, the CATPAW must provide reports at least semiannually indicating program progress and measurement of the alternative treatment on these road segments; and

Whereas, Ouray County will not treat these road segments with commercial weed spray pending evaluation indicating the results of alternative weed control treatment on these road segments by CATPAW and upon review and oversight by the Ouray County Weed employee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ouray, Colorado that Resolution # 2003-045 be adopted as outlined above.
