

**RESOLUTION
OF
THE BOARD OF OURAY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

**Concerning: Surplus Personal Property Declaration
To be Disposed of via Posted Advertisement**

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, have determined that consistent procedures should be followed by all Ouray County elected officials, department heads, and staff for the disposal of surplus property; and

Whereas, the Board seeks to assure itself and the public of maximum economies to be achieved through fair and equitable practices outlined in the Ouray County Disposal of Surplus Property Policy; and

Whereas, the Sheriff's office has submitted a request to sell via an advertised sealed bid process two vehicles, and to utilize the revenue received to offset costs of departmental investigative expenses for the 2004 budget year; and

Whereas, the two vehicles in question are:

- 1998 two door Jeep Cherokee with approximately 90,000 miles, and
- 1997 Jeep Cherokee with excess of 120,000 miles.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado that the above mentioned vehicles are hereby declared "Surplus Property," and that proper procedures be followed (in accordance with the Ouray County Disposal of Surplus Property Policy) for its disposal via advertisement in the legal paper of record, and that the proceeds derived from disposal of the vehicles be deposited to the "sale of assets" revenue line-item within the general fund to be used to offset new vehicle purchases in the future.
