Concerning: Surplus Personal Property Declaration Disposal
1992 Ambulance

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, has determined that consistent procedures should be followed by all Ouray County elected officials, department heads, and staff for the disposal of surplus property; and

Whereas, the Board seeks to assure itself and the public of maximum economies to be achieved through fair and equitable practices outlined in the Ouray County Disposal of Surplus Property Policy; and

Whereas, the EMS Director has sold via internet advertisement one 1992 Chevy Ambulance as per instructions by the Board of County Commissioners at a previous commissioner meeting, and

Whereas, proceeds from the sale of the ambulance will be used to purchase a trailer to be used for emergency services.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado that the above mentioned vehicle has been declared "Surplus Property;" that authorization was given for its disposal in accordance with the Ouray County Disposal of Surplus Property Policy; and that proceeds from the sale of the ambulance be used for the purchase of a trailer to be used for emergency services.
