

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE BOARD OF OURAY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Concerning: **Marketing Policy for Ouray County 4-H Event Center**

**Whereas**, at the October 18, 2004 Board of County Commissioner meeting, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") made recommendation to establish a policy indicating the desired funding mechanisms for the Ouray County 4-H Event Center facility ("Facility"); and

**Whereas**, it was the consensus of the Board that the Facility should strive to be self-sufficient and self-supporting thereby providing a positive economic impact to the businesses and citizens of Ouray County; and

**Whereas**, revenues generated from various events should be used to help offset costs and sustain other non-mandated yet essential programs to the citizens of Ouray County; and

**Whereas**, the Board supports the use of the Facility by local groups, and is hopeful that the revenue generated from non-local groups will be enough to help offset operating and maintenance costs and to subsidize local group functions; and

**Whereas**, the Board has tentatively agreed on a case-by-case basis, to allow the Facility to be used for dances and other revenue generating functions as long as the County is not in competition with local businesses and local service organization events.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado that Resolution #2004-052 is adopted setting forth the Board's desired direction for marketing the Facility .
