Re: Addition of "Wildlife Shelter" as a use by Special Use Permit

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners for Ouray County, Colorado held at the Court House, Ouray, Colorado on the 6th day of June A.D., **2005**.

When the following proceedings, among others, were had and done, to-wit:

WHEREAS, Land Use Department staff has submitted to the Board of County Commissioners a recommendation that "Wildlife Shelter" be added as a use by Special Use Permit in the Alpine, High Mesa, North Mesa, Public Lands, South Slope and Valley Zones; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed the recommendation in accordance with Section 2.4 of the Ouray County Land Use Code during a regular meeting on the 6th day of June, 2005 and is ready to take action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, those in accordance with Section 2.4 of the Ouray County Land Use Code, the Board of County Commissioners do hereby accept the staff recommendation and APPROVE the additional use in the specified zones with the following condition:

- 1. Any proposed Wildlife Shelter will be subject to all provisions of the Special Use Permit process under Section 5 of the Ouray County Land Use Code.
