**Re: Authorization for I. T. Manager to sign Specific Qwest T-1
Agreements for e-Recording Project**

Whereas, various Qwest Agreements, acknowledgments, and addendums (“Agreements”) were necessary to sign concerning placement of the order for T-1 line installations associated with the County Clerk and Recorder’s mandated, e-Recording grant software purchase approved by the Board of County Commissioners on September 19, 2005; and

Whereas, in order to expedite the installation of T-1 lines it was necessary for the I. T. Manager to sign the “Agreements” ordering such installation; and

Whereas, the governing body for Ouray County Government pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes § 30-11-107 (1)(aa) has the power at any meeting *“to establish policies and procedures regarding entering into contracts binding on the county, and to delegate its power to enter into such contracts pursuant to such policies and procedures.”*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County in order to expeditiously cause the ordering and installation of T-1 lines associated with the Clerk and Recorder’s mandated e-Recording software hereby authorizes Michael Elden, County I. T. Manager to sign the “Agreements” listed below:

1. Qwest iQ Internet Port Service Agreement,
2. Qwest Corporation Frame Relay Acknowledgment,
3. Qwest Communications Corporation Terms and Conditions,
4. Non-Appropriations Addendum,
5. Addendum to Qwest Internet Master Service Agreement, and
6. FR/Internet Services Maintenance and Installation.
