Re: **Horsefly Fire Protection Association**

Whereas, on May 1, 2006 the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) of Ouray County, Colorado, met with Larry Behrends, Fire Chief for the Horsefly Fire Protection Association (“HFPA”), the Ouray County Sheriff, and Ouray County Road Superintendent regarding road improvements for wild land firefighting efforts within the HFPA area; and

Whereas, the HFPA is desirous of keeping a fire truck on Wildcat Canyon Road, and another fire truck on Mariposa Drive to respond to wildfires within the area; and

Whereas, in order for the fire trucks and area residents to expediently and safely traverse Wildcat Canyon Road and Mariposa Drive, the HFPA is requesting that the County bring portions of these roads listed below up to specifications as set forth in Ouray County Road Standards:

- 1) A one mile segment on Wildcat Canyon Road west from Government Springs Road, and
- 2) A one-mile segment on Mariposa Drive east from Government Springs Road; and

Whereas, pursuant to the request by HFPA, the Board has suggested that the Road Superintendent provide assistance on the above-mentioned roads under the following perimeters:

- To provide assistance in the form of labor, equipment and materials as available,
- To preserve as many trees and other vegetation within the 60-foot right-of-way, and
- To try and accomplish this work in the Spring of 2006.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, based upon the health, safety and welfare of HFPA residents, firefighters and citizenry that improvements on a one mile segment on Wildcat Canyon Road west from Government Springs Road, and a one-mile segment on Mariposa Drive east from Government Springs Road be accomplished through cooperation and assistance of the Ouray County Road and Bridge department based upon the perimeters set forth above.
