

**RESOLUTION
OF
THE OURAY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

Concerning: Ouray County's Policy for the County Website

Whereas, the Ouray County Board of County Commissioners has determined that the establishment of a County website would be a beneficial and important tool and resource for public communication and information; and

Whereas, the County website is structured to meet the needs of the majority of the public using an industry-standard web browser; and

Whereas, the County has limited resources and staff, and is not able to accommodate all of the non-standard browsers available to the public but has made every effort to accommodate the majority of users through the industry standard; and

Whereas, each County department's individual web page on the County website is designed to provide the most information available in a concise and manageable format.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the Ouray County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

- The Board has determined that the industry-standard web browser, Internet Explorer, is the most efficient and comprehensive method of meeting the requirements of the majority of users of the County website, and
- In order to present the information in the most concise manner possible and to avoid each department's web page from becoming too unwieldy and confusing to the public, the Board has directed that each web page be limited in size as determined by the I.T. Manager and as described in the Technology Policy.
