

**RESOLUTION
OURAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

Re: Planning Commission Procedural Process to the Board of County Commissioners

WHEREAS, pursuant to 30-28-103 Colorado Revised Statutes, “the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to appoint a commission of not less than three and not more than nine members, to be known as the county planning commission; except that, in counties of the state having a population of fifteen thousand or less desiring to establish a commission, the Board of County Commissioner may constitute the commission or appoint a separate body to serve as the county planning commission;” and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 30-28-104 Colorado Revised Statutes, “the Board of County Commissioners has the authority to employ experts and a staff as deemed necessary for carrying out the powers conferred and the duties prescribed in this article. The county planning commission is directed to make use of the expert advice and information which may be furnished by appropriate federal, state, county, and municipal officials, departments and agencies and in particular by the director of the division of planning in the department of local affairs of the state of Colorado;” and

WHEREAS, in order to better effectuate the Planning Commission advisory recommendations, the Board of County Commissioners is setting forth a procedural process, which will improve communication between the Board of County Commissioners, Planning Commission and staff, expedite the process, and increase efficiencies as follows:

1. Upon approval of Planning Commission Resolutions and Minutes, the Land Use Administrator will contact the County Administrator to schedule a time on the next available Board of County Commissioner’s agenda to bring forth the Planning Commission’s recommendation on applications, master plan amendments, code development, code changes, etc.

2. The Board of County Commissioners will review Planning Commission’s recommendations on applications, master plan amendments, code development, code changes, etc., make a decision on a course of action by Board Resolution, which will then be conveyed back to the Planning Commission by the Land Use Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray, Colorado that this procedural process is adopted as written above. Amendments to the procedural process may be considered as necessary by resolution from the Planning Commission following the procedures listed above, and by staff to the Board of County Commissioners.
