

**A RESOLUTION OF THE
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OURAY COUNTY, COLORADO
APPROVING THE AMOUNT OF THE SURETY BOND FOR
THE OURAY COUNTY SHERIFF**

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §30-10-501 indicates that prior to the Sheriff entering into office, he shall execute a bond, with at least three sufficient sureties, in such penal sum not less than five thousand nor more than twenty thousand dollars

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §30-10-501 further indicates that the Board of County Commissioners shall approve the amount of the bond for the County Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, determined at its regular meeting on December 18, 2006, that the appropriate amount of the bond for the Ouray County Sheriff should be in the amount of \$15,000 of which is equal to the amounts of three separate sureties of \$5,000 each.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OURAY COUNTY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The amount of the bond for the Ouray County Sheriff for his term of office shall be \$15,000 of which is equal to the amounts of three separate sureties of \$5,000 each.
