**RESOLUTION
OURAY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

**Re: Authorization for the Road Superintendent to Approve Supplemental Signage
Adjacent to Ouray County Roads**

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-11-107(1)(n) "Powers of the Board" the Board of County Commissioners has created the position of Road Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, when so created, the Board has the power to prescribe the duties to be performed by such appointees; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the day-to-day operations of Ouray County will be more effective and efficient by granting the Road Superintendent the authority to make decisions regarding supplemental traffic control road signage on the County's behalf in the County's right-of-way.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, that the Road Superintendent shall be authorized to make decisions as to the content and design of supplemental traffic control road signage on the County rights-of-way and enter into agreements with individuals or citizen groups regarding the placement of such signage. Any agreements so entered into shall not create an undue financial burden on the County, nor significantly impact the normal, day-to-day operations of Ouray County Road and Bridge Department, provided, however, that the Road Superintendent shall advise the County Administrator in writing of any such agreements.
