to Accommodate 2007 Election Preparations**

**Whereas**, the Ouray County Clerk and Recorder has determined that it would be in the best interest of the county in general and her office in particular to ensure a smooth and trouble-free election process for the 2007 election; and

**Whereas**, it would benefit the Clerk’s Office to balance and secure ballots received on a daily basis; and

**Whereas**, such actions are necessary to comply with unfunded state and federal mandates; and

**Whereas**, it is imperative to work the “counting process” in a secured environment; and

**Whereas**, it would be helpful to avoid evening or late night work schedules for election judges; and

**Whereas**, it would benefit the County to avoid overtime costs for staff acting in the capacity of election judge.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County that the Clerk and Recorder’s Office be allowed to close at 3 p.m. from Monday, October 29, 2007 through Tuesday, November 6, 2007.
