Concerning: Surplus Property Declaration  
*To be disposed of in accordance with the Surplus Property Policy*

**Whereas**, the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, has determined that consistent procedures should be followed by all Ouray County elected officials, department heads, and staff for the disposal of surplus property; and

**Whereas**, the Board seeks to assure itself and the public of maximum economies to be achieved through fair and equitable practices outlined in the Ouray County Disposal of Surplus Property Policy; and

**Whereas**, the following property meets the surplus property criteria set forth in the Surplus Property Policy, Section 2C, that states “the property is damaged, worn out or otherwise inoperable and the cost of repairing the same is unwise or impractical;” and Section 2D that states “the property has been utilized for a period of time equal to its useful life;” and

**Whereas**, the following property meets the surplus property criteria set forth in the Surplus Property Policy, Section 3.B., fourth paragraph, that states “When so directed by the Board of County Commissioners, the County Administrator or designated representative shall proceed to sell the same through a noticed public auction....”
