

**RESOLUTION
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OURAY COUNTY**

Re: Relocation of Polling Place - Precincts 3 and 5 (Ridgway)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, met in regular session on _____, 2008; and

WHEREAS, according to Colorado Revised Statute 1-5-101, and subject to approval by the Board of County Commissioners, the County Clerk and Recorder of each county shall divide the county into as many election precincts for all elections as is convenient for the eligible electors of the county and shall designate the place for each precinct at which elections are to be held; and

WHEREAS, voters in Precincts 3 and 5 have traditionally voted at the Ridgway Town Hall which has limited space; and

WHEREAS, to have better control of crowds, especially in the upcoming 2008 General Election, and to avoid confusion between the two separate precincts, the Clerk feels it is imperative to relocate Precincts 3 and 5 to a larger polling place; and

WHEREAS, specifically, the Clerk has recommended relocating Precincts 3 and 5 to the Ouray County 4-H Event Center; and

WHEREAS, specifically, the Ouray County 4-H Event Center meets the HAVA and ADA requirements as surveyed by the Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk & Recorder has received permission from the Board of County Commissioners to utilize the 4-H Event Center as a polling place at no cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ouray County Board of County Commissioners approves and adopts the recommendation of the Clerk to relocate the Precincts 3 and 5 polling place from the Ridgway Town Hall to the Ouray County 4-H Event Center.
