Concerning: **Surplus Property Declaration**
To be disposed of in accordance with the Surplus Property Policy

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado, has determined that consistent procedures should be followed by all Ouray County elected officials, department heads, and staff for the disposal of surplus property; and

Whereas, the Board seeks to assure itself and the public of maximum economies to be achieved through fair and equitable practices outlined in the Ouray County Disposal of Surplus Property Policy; and


Whereas, the following property meets the surplus property criteria set forth in the Surplus Property Policy, Section 2C, that states *"the property is damaged, worn out or otherwise inoperable and the cost of repairing the same is unwise or impractical;"* and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Ouray County, Colorado that the following is hereby declared "Surplus Property," and that proper procedures be followed in accordance with Ouray County Disposal of Surplus Property Policy, Section 3C that states, *"Surplus personal property, which is unsalable because of obsolescence, wear and tear, or other reasons, may be dismantled, if necessary, and sold as scrap, or properly discarded.*


