

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-039**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE  
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OURAY COUNTY, COLORADO  
REESTABLISHING LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSE FEES IN UNINCORPORATED OURAY COUNTY,  
COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, C.R.S. Title 44, Articles 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, *et seq.*, provides the terms, conditions, limitations, and restrictions concerning the manufacture and sale of malt, vinous, and spirituous liquors; and,

**WHEREAS**, said Statutes set forth certain mandates for local licensing authorities, including the Ouray County Liquor Licensing Authority; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board established local liquor license fees within unincorporated Ouray County by the adoption of Resolutions 2002-003, 2006-049, and 2007-045; and,

**WHEREAS**, there have been subsequent amendments made by the Colorado Legislature to the *Colorado Beer Code, Colorado Liquor Code, and Liquors – Special Event Permits* enumerating such amendments in C.R.S Title 44, Articles 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, *et seq.*; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to repeal all prior Resolutions pertaining to liquor licensing and fees and reestablish local liquor license fees to be current and consistent with Colorado Law;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OURAY COUNTY, COLORADO**, that Resolutions 2002-003, 2006-049, and 2007-045 are hereby repealed, and pursuant to the authority granted by Colorado Law, the local liquor license fees for unincorporated Ouray County, Colorado shall be consistent and equal to those fees identified in C.R.S. § 44-3-505, *et seq.*, as may be amended from time to time [Attached hereto as "Exhibit A"]. Subsequent changes in local liquor license application fees shall be effective January 1<sup>st</sup> without further amendment to this Resolution.



Pursuant to C.R.S. §44-3-505(5): The Local Liquor Licensing Authority may charge cooperate applicants and limited liability companies up to \$100.00 for the cost of each fingerprint analysis and background investigation undertaken to qualify new officers, directors, stockholders, members, or managers pursuant to the requirements of C.R.S. §44-3-307 (1); however, no local licensing authority shall collect such a fee if the applicant has already undergone a background investigation by and paid a fee to the state licensing authority.
