



## Unified Command Meeting Briefings for 10.13.2020

Thursday, October 13, 2020

- Public Health – working on getting Abbott testing machine, should have before December; business group meetings went well; new cases were reported over the weekend – that is 7 cases in 14 days; new test kits are coming, they are self-swab tests and they get next-day air to lab in California – these are from the state of Colorado; researching HVAC systems for restaurants and in-door dining this winter; drive-thru flu clinic will be on Friday;
- Town of Ridgway – received above-average score on COVID audit testing;
- Mental Health – new mobile response team is in training and will be available soon; tele-health is still a strong option for people during COVID; financial assistance is available; will look into a support group for those who have recovered from COVID;
- Planning Section – the Alzheimer’s group is allowing people recovering from COVID to join group to discuss loss of memory symptoms;
- PIO’s – update on business meeting from today – provided feedback and concerns from businesses on what winter looks like for restaurants; conversation about business with a pool that is not following rules and guidelines;
- County Government – still working on CARES Act reimbursement;
- City Government – EPS contract will be on council agenda for Oct. 19; awaiting results on COVID audit;
