PHO #1 & #2

- #1 Closure of Bars, Restaurants, etc.
- Drop off on April 30
- Fall under state guidance
- #2 Limit Mass Gatherings to 10 ppl

- #3 Short-term rental restrictions
 - Extend to May 15
 - Phased re-opening
- #4 14 day quarantine

TIMELINE FOR IMPLEMENTATION

Through April 26:
Stay At Home



- Last Day of Stay at Home Order
- Safer at Home Order Issued

April 27:
Safer at Home



- Retail - Curbside can begin
- Real Estate - showings can resume

May 1 (Friday):
Safer at Home



- Can open if implementing best practices:
- Retail
 - Some personal Services

May 4 (Monday):
Safer at Home



- Can open if implementing best practices:
- Office work at reduced density

State's Guidance (safer at home)

APRIL 27

- Retail businesses can open for curbside pickup and delivery if they choose to
- Elective surgeries can continue
- Medical and dental offices can reopen under strict social distancing precautions
- Personal services (salons, dog grooming, personal training, tattoo parlors) can reopen under strict social distancing precautions
- In-person real estate showings can begin, no open houses

State's Guidance

MAY 1

Under strict precautions, retail businesses can open to the public beyond curbside pickup and delivery

MAY 4

Large workplaces at 50% of the in-person workforce, with symptoms and temperature checks as employees enter

MID-MAY

Gov. Polis doesn't have a set date, but said his goal for phased restaurant, bar and club reopening, under strict social distancing measures is "Mid-May," and that "we will make adjustments in real-time based on the data and modeling."

State's Guidance (safer at home)

- Vulnerable populations and older adults must stay home unless absolutely necessary
- No group gatherings of more than 10 ppl
- Critical businesses remain open with strict precautions (social distancing, masks for employees, more frequent cleaning, etc.)
